Then it's off on a two hour safari adventure. The Morrison family will take us on a 4 wheel drive tour to showcase their exotic animal collection, their black angus cattle operation, 6 million year old aquatic fossil hills, and an epic view from the center of their 50 square mile ranch.

All painting experience levels welcome, and no plein air experience is necessary. This adventure is limited to only 10 people, so there's plenty of individual attention in the pastel workshop and plenty of opportunity to get to know the Morrison family and learn about their family ranching history.
